Ayang Monastery Clinic

Ayang Monastery is located at 14,800 feet elevation near Rima village, Tibet and sits beside the Lake of Compassion, revered as the palace of the 21Tara deities.

Due to Rinpoche's efforts, nomads in the area now have a clinic, two doctors on staff and an ambulance. The clinic services a catchment area of nearly 10,000 people.

The doctors provide traditional Tibetan medicine, as well as Western treatments, and currently see up to 60 patients per day. Grants have made it possible to further expand the clinic this year.



Your support will help provide a well for clean water, vaccines, medicines, support for the doctors and a new midwife, clean birthing kits and training to promote safe childbirth and reduce maternal and infant mortality.

Ayang Monastery Boarding School

As of 2009 there are 129 boys and girls between the ages of 7-18 living and studying at the new boarding school in Rima.

Children learn Tibetan, Chinese, music, dancing, math and hygiene. Life is challenging for nomad families, and they must sacrifice a great deal to send a child to school.
